



Published June 2008, Architectural Excellence delv deeply into the responsibility of each wo culture to develop its own unique voice its architectural expression. "The ultima goal for an architectural style is to matu to stand the test of time, to be perfect as it is repeated by multiple generatio When architecture achieves this lofty go then it speaks with a voice that transcen its originating culture and can be admir and appreciated by all," he reasons.

Baker made his debut on architectur world stage with the 2004 publication of firm's monograph, New Classicists, a rema ably beautiful keepsake volume showcasi 28 extraordinary Baker projects throught the United States. The book became a reaway success and is now in its third printing the U.S. and sixth printing in Asia. In fact, Ber reports signed first editions of the book now commanding upwards of \$350. Thou all the homes profiled in New Classicists strikingly diverse, they share one Baker sign ture: a design based on tradition that draupon the best from the past and reinterprit for the present.

As he opens his Greenwich office, he do so as founder and principal of one of the formost architectural firms in the U.S. specializing in spectacular private residences. He has ceived numerous awards for his work, including the prestigious Arthur Ross Award for Architeture in New York City and the Urban Desi Commission Award for Excellence in Atlanta

he says. "I'm on the search throughout the year, looking for ideas, exploring favorite house museums in this country and abroad. Travel is critical for new inspiration."

When asked what sets him apart, Baker is refreshingly matter-of-fact. "I've deliberately kept my firm small in order to provide handson attention to every project. When a family hires me to design their home, they get me for the duration of the project. There is no one in a back room who is eventually assigned to them. I am on every phone call, every conver-

sation regarding the house and know all the history. I also help them in the assembly of their team—the builders, craftsmen and engineers who will be with them for the duration of the project. It's critical that the personal dynamics are a great fit," says Baker.
